Allison Peter puts in incredible performance at CARIFTA...wins Bronze Medal...

The VITFF announced today that Allison Peter, a student/athlete at the St. Croix Complex High School and the Jr. Barracudas Track Club had an incredible performance at the XXXVIII CARIFTA Championships in St. Lucia on Saturday as she won the Bronze medal in the 100 meters with a time of 11.50 (wind aided)! Peter moved up to the Under 20 age-group this year where making it to the finals is considered a major accomplishment as she is competing against the absolute top junior sprinters to be found. And. With the current world dominance of the Caribbean in the sprints, her performance is a tremendous help in establishing her potential. Eyes were opened when she accomplished her Bronze medal performance while running in lane 8! It took two Jamacians to beat her including: Carrie Russell with an 11.21 and Jura Levy with an 11.33.

Peter, won the CARIFTA Gold medal last year in the 200m and the Silver medal in the 100m with a time of 11.91. She now joins the ranks of the top V.I. National Team sprinters including: Laverne Jones, Courtney Patterson and Valma Bass. Her wind aided time, including the two first place finishers in Saturday's race, places her in the top twelve in the world on the IAAF world list for senior women! The woman listed at the top of the world list? V.I. record holder and two-time Olympian, Laverne Jones! This is truly an exceptional performance for the youngster! In fact, Jones toping the list is an equally incredible performance. Only the Virgin Islands can make this claim at this particular time in history.
