Teams Orientation Tour and Technical Meeting

A Teams Orientation Tour will be organised on Thursday 12 March 2020 at 10:00. No Technical Meeting will be organised but the Technical Delegates, World Athletics and LOC Competition Management will be available for questions at the end of the Orientation Tour.

Timetable

The Timetable was approved by the Council in March 2019 and included at Appendix B.

List of Implements

The List of Official Implements is set out in Appendix C.

ENTRIES

Age Categories

U20 athletes: any athlete aged 18 or 19 years on 31 December 2020 (born in 2002 or 2001) may compete in any event.

U18 athletes: any athlete aged 16 or 17 years on 31 December 2020 (born in 2004 or 2003) may compete in any event except the Shot Put.

Athletes younger than 16 years on 31 December 2020 (born in 2005 or later) cannot compete in any event.

Entry Standards and Entry Rules

These were approved by the Council in March 2019 – please refer to Appendix D for details.

We would however like to bring the following to your attention:

- **Horizontal Jumps and Shot Put:**

The Horizontal Jumps and Shot Put will be held as straight Finals with 16 athletes starting in each event. These events will be conducted as follows:

- The top eight after three rounds have two additional attempts
- The top four after five rounds have one last attempt.

- **High Jump and Pole Vault:**

The Men's and Women's High Jump and Pole Vault events will be held as straight Finals with 12 athletes starting in each event.

- **Seedings, Draws and Qualification in Track Events:**

To accommodate the large number of entries in some events, alternate tables to those provided for in Rule 215.1 may be used by the Technical Delegates for seeding, draws and qualifications in Track Events. See Alternate Tables in Appendix B of the [Technical Regulations](#).

For the first round of the 800m, if seven or eight athletes are required to run in one heat, they will be placed in lane five when there is one additional athlete and in lanes two and five when there are two additional athletes.

- **Unqualified Athletes:**

Members who have no male and/or no female qualified athletes whom they wish to enter in any Championships event, may enter one unqualified male athlete OR one unqualified female athlete in a running event (except the 800m). In exceptional cases, and as agreed by the Technical Delegates, entry of unqualified athletes in the 800m, Long Jump, Triple Jump or Shot Put may be accepted. Applications for such entries must be submitted to World Athletics (events@iaaf.org) **by no later than 24 February 2020.**

Submission of Entries and Deadlines

Preliminary Entries	Member Federations must submit their Preliminary Entries online using the World Athletics online Event Entry System (EES) (http://evententry.iaaf.org) by 14 December 2019 midnight, Monaco time. Preliminary Entries may be submitted starting 14 November 2019.
Final Entries	Final Entries must also be submitted online using the World Athletics online EES, by 2 March 2020 midnight, Monaco time. Final Entries may be submitted starting 2 February 2020.
Final Confirmations	Teams will receive the Final Confirmation Forms upon arrival in Nanjing and Team Leaders, or their representatives, must confirm the names of those athletes already entered who will participate in the competition. Final Confirmations for all events must be made, at the latest, by 12:00 on Thursday 12 March 2020 with the World Athletics Statisticians at the Team Accreditation Centre.

FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Good Standing

Financial support is offered to those participating Member Federations which are in “Good Standing” with World Athletics. Quota

The Athlete Quota for Member Federations is set out in Appendix E.

Travel

For all athletes in the Quota, 100% of an economy class airline ticket from the Member Federation headquarters to the Championships’ official airport will be paid by the LOC. These tickets will be issued preferably by World Athletics, provided Member Federations send their Preliminary Entries and Final Entries by the respective deadlines.

If a Member Federation prefers to purchase the airline tickets, the price of such tickets must be submitted together with the Preliminary Entries and be approved by World Athletics beforehand, knowing that the cheapest available price will be taken as a reference. Only the approved travel costs will be reimbursed upon the submission of the corresponding invoice(s). The original invoice from the travel agency must be given to World Athletics on site, during the accreditation procedure.

Accommodation

For all athletes in the Quota, the LOC will offer free accommodation in twin rooms during the official period (arrival, Wednesday 11 March – departure, Monday 16 March), for a maximum of five nights. Single rooms will be charged a supplement (see “Costs” below).

Reimbursements

Reimbursements will be made by bank transfer after the competition.

If an athlete for whom World Athletics/ the LOC have provided financial support is on site but does not compete, World Athletics/ the LOC have the right to reclaim the travel and accommodation support.

Competition Awards

Prize Money

During the World Athletics Indoor Championships, the top six athletes or teams in each event will be awarded the following prizes by World Athletics:

Payments will be made following confirmation of doping control tests and submission of complete Award Forms with full bank details. The LOC has confirmed that there will be no taxes to be paid on prize money.

The Award Form for Individual Events can be found in Appendix G. It must be returned to awards@iaaf.org but it will also be possible to return it to the Stadium Technical Information Centre. The Relay awards will be managed directly with the Member Federations concerned.

World Record Bonus

In the event that an athlete breaks a World Record during the World Athletics Indoor Championships, a prize of USD 50,000 will be awarded. The World Record Bonus will only be awarded for performances which improve the existing World Indoor Record, and which meet all the necessary conditions for recognition as a World Athletics Indoor Record, in accordance with World Athletics Regulations and after ratification of the record by World Athletics. Full details of the regulations regarding this prize are available from World Athletics upon request.

Rights and Obligations in Relation to the Prize Money and World Record Bonus

Athletes receiving IAAF Prize Money must make themselves available to World Athletics and its sponsors, at least twice in the 12 next months, for promotional activities, upon requests handled by World Athletics.

Should an athlete's Doping Control results return positive, the awards and bonuses won will be withheld.

Financial Penalties

Member Federations must respect the deadlines and provide accurate information in their entries in order to avoid causing unnecessary financial impact to the LOC. Failure to do so may result in financial penalties being imposed as detailed below. The penalties will be debited to the account of the Member Federation with World Athletics.

Respect of Deadlines	A penalty of USD 1,000 may be imposed on any Federation which does not respect the Preliminary and/or Final Entry deadlines.
Realistic Entries	A penalty of USD 1,000 per athlete, after the first two, may be imposed on Member Federations which: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• after having announced through the Preliminary Entries their participation in a World Athletics competition, do not take part;• after having entered in the Preliminary Entries more than two athletes, attend the competition with a number of athletes 25% or more higher or lower than the entered number.

ACCOMMODATION

Extra Officials (above 55% quota – see Appendix F)

The number of officials that can be accommodated with the team at subsidised rates will be limited to a quota corresponding to 55% of the athletes (see chart in Appendix F). An additional 25% of non-subsidised officials (up to an overall maximum of 80%) will be accommodated in the Team hotels subject to availability.

If you need accommodation for officials above the 55% quota, please contact the LOC directly. If it is possible for them to be accommodated with the team, the costs indicated below will apply.

Accommodation invoices will be based on the information (number of persons and arrival/departure details) provided at the closing date for the Final Entries (2 March midnight Monaco Time), with a tolerance of two persons. Any cancellation received after 2 March (after the first two persons) will be considered as a no-show and will be invoiced by the LOC to the Member Federation for the corresponding reservation period.

Payment of extra costs can be made:

- by credit card: Mastercard or Visa
- in cash: CNY, USD or EUR (the prevailing exchange rate will be agreed on the day the Main Team Accreditation Centre opens).

Hotel Services

Dedicated rooms for teams' physiotherapy staff and team meetings will be available at each hotel.

ATHLETES' CLOTHING

Uniform

Athletes shall participate in the uniform clothing approved by their National Member Federation. The Medal Ceremony is considered part of the competition for this purpose. In accordance with the Rules and Regulations concerning uniforms, National Member Federation kit must be approved by World Athletics and Athletes of the same team must wear National Member Federation uniform with the same design. Please submit uniform/team kits to kitapprovals@iaaf.org. All Member

Federations must bring their team uniform to the accreditation centre for inspection, during the accreditation procedures.

DOPING CONTROL

Doping control will be conducted in accordance with World Athletics Regulations and Guidelines and under the supervision of World Athletics Medical/Anti-Doping Delegate.

INSURANCE

A separate Circular specifically dedicated to team insurance coverage for emergency medical costs during the travel and stay abroad for all athletes and officials at 2020 World Athletics Series competitions will be issued in January 2020.

Additional Implements may be added to the approved list, if requested by Member Federations directly or by Manufacturers with the endorsement of a Member Federation, by 30 November 2019, and if supplied to the LOC free of charge. All such implements must have World Athletics certification and must be approved by World Athletics Technical Delegates. Three items of each implement must be supplied by the Member Federation or Manufacturer concerned and must be sent to the LOC by 31 January 2020 at the latest.

Personal Implements will also be allowed, providing that:

- they are readily identifiable and are World Athletics certified;
- they are not already on the official list;
- they have been checked for compliance with World Athletics Rules;
- they are made available to all the other athletes.

**WORLD ATHLETICS INDOOR CHAMPIONSHIPS – NANJING 2020
ENTRY RULES AND STANDARDS**

ENTRY RULES

- **Running Events** (except the Relays)
 - Each Member is entitled to enter up to three athletes in each event of the Championships, provided all have achieved the corresponding Entry Standard.
 - Entries in running events will be determined by a combination of entry standards and performance lists.
 - A maximum of two athletes from any Member Federation may compete in each event.
 - The Women's **3000m** event will be held as a straight Final.

- **Field Events**
 - In the **High Jump** and **Pole Vault**, the events will be held as straight Finals with 12 athletes starting in each event. The Entries will be determined by a combination of Entry Standards and performance lists.
 - In the **Long Jump, Triple Jump and Shot Put**, events will be held as straight Finals with 16 athletes starting in each event. Entries will be determined by a combination of entry standards and performance lists. The event will be conducted as follows:
 - All athletes have three initial trials
 - The top eight athletes after three rounds of trials have two additional trials
 - The top four athletes after five rounds of trials have one last trial.
 - In all cases, a maximum of two athletes from any one Member Federation may compete in each event.

- **Combined Events**
 - 12 athletes will be invited in the **Heptathlon** and in the **Pentathlon** as follows:
 - the winner of the 2019 Combined Events Challenge
 - the five best athletes from the 2019 Outdoor Lists (as at 31 December 2019), limited to a maximum of one per country
 - the five best athletes from the 2020 Indoor Lists (as at 24 February 2020)
 - one athlete who may be invited at the discretion of World Athletics
 - In total no more than two male and two female athletes from any one Member will be invited. Upon refusals or cancellations, the invitations will be extended to the next ranked athletes in the same lists respecting the above conditions.

- For the **Relays**, there is no entry standard, and each Member Federation will be able to enter up to eight athletes in each team.

- **World Indoor Tour:** The individual overall winner of each event of the World Indoor Tour 2019 and 2020 will automatically qualify for the World Athletics Indoor Championships by Wild Card. The Member Federation of the World Athletics Indoor Tour winner will have the ultimate authority to enter the athlete or not, based on its own criteria or qualification system. If a Member Federation has three athletes qualified as a result, all three will be permitted to compete.

- **Unqualified Athletes**
 - Members who have **no male and/or no female qualified athletes** (whether eligible by Entry Standard or by subsequent ranking) in any event may enter one unqualified male athlete OR one unqualified female athlete in a running event (except the 800m). In exceptional cases, and as agreed by the Technical Delegates, entry of unqualified athletes in the 800m, Long Jump, Triple Jump or Shot Put may be accepted.

Applications for such entries must be submitted to World Athletics (events@iaaf.org) by no later than **24 February 2020**.

- If the **host country** does not have a qualified athlete in an event, it may enter one athlete in this event regardless of any Entry Standard (except for the Combined Events). For the Field Events and 800m, the entry is at the discretion of the Technical Delegates.

Athletes younger than 16 years on 31 December 2020 (born in 2005 or later) may not compete in any event.

- Performances must be achieved during the **qualification period** of 1 January 2019 to 2 March 2020 (midnight Monaco time), except for the Combined Events (see above).
- Performances must be achieved during **competitions organised or authorised by World Athletics**, its Area Associations or its National Member Federations. Thus, results achieved at university or school competitions must be certified by the National Federation of the country in which the competition was organised.
- Performances must be achieved during an official competition organised in **conformity with World Athletics Rules**.
- Performances achieved in **mixed competitions in track events** will not be accepted. Exceptionally, in accordance with the World Athletics Competition Rule 147, performances achieved in the 5000m event may be accepted in circumstances where there were insufficient athletes of one or both genders competing to justify the conduct of separate races and there was no pacing or assistance given by an athlete(s) of one gender to an athlete(s) of the other gender under specific circumstances and conditions (see Rule 147).
- **Wind-assisted performances** will not be accepted.
- **Hand-timed performances** in 60m, 100m, 400m, 800m, 60m Hurdles, and 100m/110m Hurdles will not be accepted.
- For the running events of 400m and over, performances achieved on **oversized tracks** will NOT be accepted.
